HCR 3 Geren

Providing for adjournment sine die of the 88th Legislature, 1st Called Session.

HJR 1 Meyer

Proposing a constitutional amendment excepting certain appropriations to pay for school district ad valorem tax relief from the constitutional limitation on the rate of growth of appropriations.
