The following bills were introduced, read first time, and referred to the committees indicated:

**SB 7** by Middleton, Kolkhorst

Relating to the designation and use of certain spaces and facilities according to biological sex; authorizing a civil penalty and a private civil right of action.  
To Committee on State Affairs.

**SB 13** by Perry

Relating to the provision by a political subdivision of credits against impact fees to builders and developers for certain water conservation and reuse projects.  
To Committee on Disaster Preparedness and Flooding.

**SB 14** by King

Relating to certain files maintained by a law enforcement agency regarding certain employees of the agency.  
To Committee on State Affairs.

**SB 15** by West

Relating to recording requirements for certain documents concerning real property.  
To Committee on Finance.
